




1610, French (protestant) king assassinated.

including Mohawk who made peace with the Dutch in 1613.





Kaswentha, 1613

the culture of giving.







The Great Swamp Fight



- *Kin* = 1 Day.
- *Uinal* = 20 *kin* = 20 days.
- *Tun* = 18 *uinal* = 360 days.
- *Katun* = 20 *tun* = 360 *uinal* = 7,200 days.
- *Baktun* = 20 *katun* = 400 *tun* = 7,200 *uinal* = 144,000 days.
- Long count = 2,880,000 days (7885 years)




